### C-Squad

**Warrant Service/1000 blk S Washington St-** Officers contacted a male and female having a verbal disturbance at the Burger King. The male had a confirmed felony warrant out of Walla Walla DOC. He was booked on his warrant.

**Stolen Vehicle/300 blk E 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Complainant reported that her 1999 Honda Accord was attempted stolen during the night. She and her husband awoke to find their car out in the middle of the street. It is believed that the suspect attempted to steal their car but for some reason was not able to. It may have been due to the car having a manual transmission. Another Honda was stolen just down the street, which may be related.

**Stolen Vehicle/00 blk W 4<sup>th</sup>-** Complainant reported that her 1996 red Honda Accord was stolen during the night. The car had been parked at her residence. Vehicle entered as stolen. There are no suspects.

**Vehicle Prowl/3600 blk S Johnson St-** Complainant reported that someone **entered her unlocked car** during the night and stole music CD's. There are no suspects.

### A-Squad

**Hit and Run/100 blk E 7<sup>th</sup>-** Complainant found her parked 2012 Nissan Rogue struck by unknown vehicle causing damage to the driver's side door. No suspects.

**Assault/10<sup>th</sup> & Washington-** First male saw second male in the area and second male wanted to speak to the first. Upon approaching him the second male lunged at the first and punched him in the face then grabbed a hold of him and went to the ground.

Second male then ran off and the first male said he didn't know why he wanted to hit him. Forwarded to the City Attorney for charges.

***Hit and Run/Columbia Center Blvd & Rio Grande-*** Complainant was at the light at Columbia Center Blvd and Rio Grande when a black Nissan SUV occupied by a dark skinned male with an unknown accent and a mustache. He then fled the scene.

***Theft from Vehicle/7000 blk W Canal Dr-*** Complainant found her vehicle's hatchback opened and a small end table missing from her car. She believed she ***the car may have been inadvertently unlocked*** when she put the key fob in her pocket.

***Assault/2700 blk S Quillan St-*** 17 year old female was in the store when a male walked by her and grabbed her rear end. He then walked away. The male was familiar to a friend who was with the complainant and later, through Facebook, identified the 17 year old male. Investigation continuing.

## **Tuesday, August 30, 2016**

### **C-Squad**

***Hit & Run Arrest/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-*** Officer Nebeker investigated a parking lot hit and run at the mall that was reported on 8/21. Today he located and arrested the suspect. The male driver was interviewed and admitted to the hit and run.

***Trespass/500 blk N Jean-*** Officers were called to a vacant residence that neighbors had seen people entering. The responsible for the property had called after being notified by the neighbors and was on scene. Officers removed four persons from inside the home. The house was obviously vacant. They had entered through a back door that was accessible. They originally claimed to be renters but did not have a key, know who they rented from, or any paperwork to support that. All were booked for trespass.

***Trespass/300 blk W 6<sup>th</sup> Ave-*** City parks employee called to report a male sleeping in the bathroom. Suspect was contacted inside. He was previously trespassed from the pool and was arrested for Trespass 1<sup>st</sup>.

***Mental/00 blk E 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave-*** 28 year old male called Crisis response last night to say he had tried to smother his 3 month old daughter. He has known mental health issues and it is not known if an assault actually took place. Crisis notified KPD of the possible assault. Officers followed up with the mother of the child who has custody. The child did not show any signs of being assaulted. Mom is going to follow up with a Doctor to ensure health of the child. The male had gone to Prosser to his parents' home. Prosser PD attempted contact with him and told them he did not want to talk to Police. He has since made suicidal statements and had access to a weapon that his family took away.

The mother was provided info on no contact orders, and will follow up with Officers after medical examination of the child.

***Fraud/800 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-*** Loss Prevention called to report a male trying to fraudulently return a vacuum. The male did this on the 26<sup>th</sup> where he picked a vacuum off the shelf and "returned" it to customer service in exchange for a gift card. The suspect attempted the same thing today but got nervous and fled prior to police arrival. Investigation continuing.

## **A-Shift**

***Suspicious Circumstances/2600 blk W Bruneau-*** 60 year old male called 911 advising there was a man with a gun at his location and that he couldn't talk. As several officers quickly arrived on scene, he was evasive and uncooperative with dispatch. He eventually came outside for officers after several minutes of hailing him. He advised a 37 year old male brandished a gun when he would let him inside. He also said the male was in his room earlier eating dinner with him. That male was not present or located. His story was not making sense and he appeared to be under the influence of prescription medication and hallucinating again.

***Theft Shoplifting Arrest/6600 blk W Canal Dr-*** Officers responded to a shoplift suspect that had left in a vehicle with another male. Officers made a traffic stop in the parking lot and detained the male suspect. While patting the handcuffed male down, he pushed away and tried to flee while still in handcuffs. He got about 30 feet away and tripped over his own feet, falling face first onto the blacktop. He sustained a laceration above his left eye from the fall and was transported to Trios for medical treatment and medical clearance. He was eventually booked into jail for theft, resisting and obstructing arrest and several outstanding warrants. Narcotics were also found on him and will be sent to WSP lab for future narcotic charges.

***Collision & DUI Arrest/1500 blk S Washington St-*** 53 year old male crashed into a wooden fence while driving down Washington St. He was obviously intoxicated and a neighbor assisted after the crash and took his keys from the ignition. He was arrested for DUI after a PBT test.

***Felony DV Arrest/00 blk N Sheppard Pl-*** 26 year old male assaulted his girlfriend by kicking her in the face and then stuffing fabric into her mouth to stop her from screaming and gagging her. He was uncooperative after officers arrested him for DV aggravated assault and resisted arrest. He was also charged with unlawful imprisonment for not allowing his girlfriend leave the apartment before and after she was assaulted.

## CAT

**Recovered Stolen Vehicle/8500 blk W Gage Blvd-** Detectives located a stolen Ford F450 truck in the parking lot. The vehicle was processed and Grandview PD was notified of the recovery. Follow up pending.

## Wednesday, August 31, 2016

### D-Squad

**Warrant Arrest/500 blk N Morain St-** DOC advised a wanted male was at the location and had valid warrants. He was contacted and arrested without incident.

**Theft from Vehicle/2400 blk W 6<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Complainant reported that her vehicle was broken into during the night. **The vehicle was unlocked** and the suspect took loose change and a phone charging cord. No leads or suspects.

**Vehicle vs. Pedestrian/4<sup>th</sup> & Union-** Traffic Officers responded to a report of a child, reported to have been struck by a vehicle. On arrival, the 15 year old male victim was found to be fine with little to no injury. The investigation revealed that he was riding his bike east on the sidewalk when the driver of a Ford Ranger, traveling west out of the roundabout completed a turn from the roadway into the driveway of their residence. The bike driver attempted to stop but slid in front of the truck where he was struck and pushed into the driveway, under the truck. The 15 year old male left with his mother after the investigation was completed.

**Robbery/800 blk S Alder-** Officers responded for a reported assault in progress. On arrival Officers contacted a female at the location. Investigation revealed that her ex-boyfriend had come to the location after having missed his court date and demanded money. She told him no and attempted to concealed her money down her shirt. He attempted to take the money, ripping her dress during his attempts. He then took two cell phones with several other items from her purse and attempted to leave in his vehicle. She attempted to stop him but was thrown to the ground. Washington State Patrol located the suspect in Prosser and turned him over to a Benton County Deputy who brought him back to Kennewick. He refused to give a statement to Kennewick Officers and was booked on Robbery charges per Benton County Prosecutor.

### B-Shift

**Auto Theft/1300 blk W 7<sup>th</sup> Pl-** Complainant reported that an unknown suspect stole her green 1996 Honda Accord. The vehicle also has the word "TINEJERE" written across the top of the rear window. The vehicle had been parked on Olympia St at the time of the theft. Entered as stolen.

**Robbery/100 blk N Irby St-** Officers responded to this residence for a report of a strong armed robbery. A 77 year old female reported that she had been at Casino and had just left. As she turned down Irby St she observed a vehicle behind her which appeared to be light in color. She pulled into her driveway and was preparing to exit her vehicle when a black male approached her on foot. The suspect yelled at her "Give to me" and then punched her multiple times in her cheek area. The suspect attempted to grab her cash winnings and keys but she fought back and was able to kick him away. The suspect fled on foot and she believes she heard a vehicle with loud exhaust leave the area. A K9 track was completed but the suspect was not located. The vehicle was processed and multiple latent prints were lifted. CAT responded to the casino and reviewed security video. Report forwarded to CID for further investigation.
