**Monday, September 12, 2016**

### A-Shift

**Graffiti/10th & Garfield-** Complainant reported new graffiti on the intersections signal box. City electrical advised they would take a photo of it prior to cleaning for the report.

**Malicious Mischief/5600 blk W Canal Dr-** Complainant reported unknown suspect damage several windows at the facility by shooting a BB/pellet gun at the building.

**Malicious Mischief/200 blk W Kennewick Ave-** Complainant advised two rear windows were damage. The manager believes the suspect may be an ex-boyfriend. Follow-up to continue.

**Theft from Vehicle/4100 blk W Metaline Ave-** Complainant advised unknown suspect **rifled thru her unlocked vehicle**. She thinks the suspect is a male she knows but she has no info to support he did it. The vehicle stereo equipment was taken.

**Theft from Vehicle/6600 blk W Canal Dr-** Unknown suspect smashed a window on the complainant's vehicle while she was working in the store and stole her coach purse, wallet, wedding ring and credit card and license.

### C-Squad

**Stolen Vehicle/100 blk S Conway St-** Complainant reported that his 1992 light brown Honda Accord was stolen from the parking lot. The vehicle has been entered as stolen. There are no suspects.

**Stolen Vehicle/200 blk N Huntington-** Complainant owns a taxi and reported that one of his company's cars had been stolen. He figured that the car was stolen sometime around the first of September. It is common for drivers to leave the keys in the vehicle

at the end of their shift if the office is closed. The keys had been left in the car that was missing. The taxi is a 2006 Toyota. The investigating Officer located the stolen vehicle as it was impounded by Othello PD on September 6 as part of a DUI/Narcotics investigation. Follow up being done with Othello PD. The car not entered as stolen.

***Suicide Attempt/3200 blk W 9<sup>th</sup> Ct-*** 14 year old female called 911 to report she had taken an unknown number of pills in an attempt to kill herself. She was awake and cooperative with police and the medics. Her mother was home at the time and stated her daughter has been dealing with several personal problems. She was transported to Trios. Crisis Response was notified.

***DUI Collision/Edison St & Umatilla Ave-*** 62 year old male was attempting to turn north onto Edison St from eastbound Umatilla Ave. He did not yield to a southbound van that with 2 adults and 4 kids. There were no serious injuries but he appeared be DUI of alcohol and medications. He was transported to BC Jail where he refused a breath sample. A search warrant was obtained for blood and a sample drawn at Trios. While at Trios he began to complain of chest pains. Due to 7 previous heart attacks, the ER Dr decided to keep him for an undetermined amount of time to make sure his condition did not worsen. He was issued a citation for DUI and released to the ER Staff.

## **Tuesday, September 13, 2016**

### **A-Shift**

***Theft from Vehicle/1800 blk W 5<sup>th</sup> Ave-*** Victim advised unknown ***suspects entered his unlocked vehicle*** and stole his two dvd monitor embedded headrests. No suspect info at this time.

***Field Arrest/Clearwater & Irving Pl-*** Officer Sullivan stopped a vehicle occupied by the adult driver and three young juveniles for seatbelt violation. The driver became belligerent, uncooperative, and would not stay seated inside the vehicle, despite the officer's orders. He got out and started walking around making the officer feel like he was going to flee before he could do a records check. When cover units arrived, the 26 year old male driver was told he was under arrest for obstructing an officer. He then resisted arrest and had to be wrestled to the ground. He was cited for the traffic violation and booked into jail for resisting and obstructing a police officer.

***Theft with Extenuating Circumstances/2700 blk S Quillan St-*** 36 year old male from East Wenatchee entered the store with the intent to commit theft. He was wearing a baggy jacket that he used to conceal a \$ 100 item, took it into the changing room and used a tool he brought with him to open the package and remove the security anti-theft device that was attached. He was arrested and booked for theft.

## C-Shift

**Assault/3800 blk Plaza Way-** Officers responded to 4000 blk W 10<sup>th</sup> where the homeowner was awoken by a female knocking on his front door. The female was very intoxicated creating a medical issue. KPD & KFD responded. She was transported to Trios due to her intoxication level. Officers had to respond to Trios twice due to her causing a disturbance. She would yell sexual terms and related language that was way outside of appropriate. At one point she masturbated in front of hospital staff and Officers. The hospital security officer had tried to calm her down, and she responded by grabbing him by the crotch and squeezing his genitals. At this point she was removed from Trios and booked for assault and interfering with medical facility.

**Burglary/1400 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Manager reported that he found 3 locks cut from the units in one of the rows of units. The business did not cut the locks and he assumes someone cut the locks to gain access to the units. Two owners were contacted and no property of any value was missing. The third unit is being contacted to check on missing property.

## Wednesday, September 14, 2016

## B-Shift

**Burglary/00 blk S Auburn St-** Officer Quinones responded to a burglary report at this business. It appears that **the side door to the business was left unsecure** during the night. An unknown suspect entered the business and pried open the cash register. Cash, candy and alcohol are missing.

**Graffiti/100 blk E 7<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Complainant reported that during the night an unknown suspect tagged her car hauler. She advised that she would handle the clean-up.

**Warrant Service/400 blk S Tweedt-** School officials reported a suspicious male on the fields of the school. Contact was made with the subject who appeared to be under the influence of meth. He was arrested on a DOC warrant and trespassed from school property.

**Trespass/5700 blk W Metaline Ave-** Complainant has a protection order against her 24 year old son. This afternoon he came by the above location but mom was not there and made no attempt to contact her. The order specifically states he cannot be at her address. However, no actual address is listed on the order. He was contacted and trespassed from the location. She was contacted and it was requested that the order be amended to include the address.

**Trespass/400 blk N Yelm St-** Several citizens called to complain of an intoxicated male yelling in the parking lot at this location. Prior to police arrival, the male threw an empty liquor bottle at the building. Officers contacted the 51 year old male who was intoxicated and uncooperative. Officers were able to place him in custody without incident. He was booked for Criminal Trespass and Littering.

**Luring/7th Ave & Edison St-** 14 year old female was walking home from school this afternoon. She stated a truck stopped alongside of her. The driver and only occupant told her to get in. She yelled "help" and ran away. She was only a couple of blocks from her residence, so she ran home and told her mom. The area was searched, and Officers could not locate the vehicle in question described as a newer white colored Dodge 4-door truck with brown colored trim on the bottom of the doors. The driver was described as a white male in his 40's with average build, brown hair and small goatee beard.

**Theft of Firearm/1900 W 9<sup>th</sup> Pl-** Complainant reported that his Smith and Wesson SDW40 .40 caliber semiautomatic pistol with stainless slide **was stolen from his unlocked truck** sometime over the past 3 weeks. No suspects or witnesses have been identified.

### **D Squad**

**Theft/2600 blk W Klamath-** Complainant reported the vehicle license plates off of a dark green 2000 Dodge Neon. The plates are AFH5141.

**Robbery/1100 blk N Buchanan-** Suspect arrived at her ex-boyfriend's house and threatened him with a pistol. He wrestled the gun away from her, but not before she fired 2 rounds one into a wall. She fled the location and managed to take his cell phone and car keys. The gun was still at the scene when officers arrived. Investigation on going.

**Narcotics/2800 blk W 10<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Officers responded to a report of a female hiding in bathroom stall and when she was contacted she said her boyfriend was in the parking lot waiting for her and she is scared of him. The boyfriend was contacted and found that he is the responded in a protection order with the victim being the protected person. He appeared to be under the influence. He kept reaching in his waistband in spite of several commands not to. When he was arrested for the order violation he was sitting down and tried to pull away from the officers and stand up. He was laid on the ground and placed in handcuffs. It was discovered he had two knives in his waistband where he had been reaching. As the vehicle was being searched incident to the arrest he again tried to reach in his waistband and had to be secured by Officer Kiel pulling his hand away from the waistband and holding him against the car. It was discovered that he was reaching for drug paraphernalia and a baggie of Methamphetamine. He was booked at the BCSO Jail for an Order Violation and Possession of Methamphetamine.

**Counterfeit/500 blk S Ely-** Complainant reported that a male had attempted to use a fake twenty to purchase some items. He used real money after he refused the transaction. The bill was on fake paper and had an S/N of MG59940906B.

**Trespass/100 blk W 14<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Complainant reported a subject was knocking on her door and then went to sleep on a bench on the porch. They were contacted and arrested for Trespass.

## Thursday, September 15, 2016

### B-Shift

**Auto Theft Attempt/1800 blk W 29<sup>th</sup> Ct-** Complainant reported that sometime during the night an unknown suspect broke out the window of his 1998 Honda Accord. It appears that the suspect was most likely attempting to steal the vehicle.

**Fail to Supervise Child/2900 blk W 7<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Officers responded for a report of a 2 year old child wandering near the intersection of 7<sup>th</sup> and US 395. The child was located and was only wearing a shirt. Eventually officers determined that the child resided at the above address. Officers were able to contact the mother who was asleep. She was arrested and booked for failure to supervise a child. The child was turned over to the step-father.

**Order Violation/1000 blk N Colorado St-** Officer Sneyd stopped a vehicle for a seatbelt violation. The driver was identified and had an outstanding warrant out of Airway Heights. He is also the respondent in a No Contact Order with the passenger in the vehicle. He was arrested and booked on the warrant and violation of a No Contact Order.

**Malicious Mischief/200 blk W Kennewick Ave-** Complainant reported that sometime during the night a large front window to the business was broken out. This is the second time the same window has been broken. She believes that her ex-boyfriend is responsible. Investigation active.

**Vehicle Prowl/7300 blk W 11<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Complainant reported that sometime during the night an unknown suspect attempted to prowl his vehicle. The suspect attempted to pry the door open causing damage to the vehicle.

**Robbery Attempt/1400 blk W 27<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Victim reported that she had parked her vehicle in the parking lot and was preparing to walk to the front door of the business. During this time a white male attempted to grab her purse. She kept hold of the purse and fell

to the ground. The suspect fled the area on foot. She sustained a swollen ankle and scrapes to her knee. No other suspect information.

## D Squad

**Assault DV/4<sup>th</sup> Ave & Olympia-** Complainant reported that her 22 year old ex-boyfriend drove up to her in his pick up and ordered her to get in. There is a served protection order between the two and she refused. He grabbed her by the arm and pulled her to the truck. She resisted and he strangled her, threw her out of the vehicle and left the scene. Officers attempted to contact the suspect but were not able to locate him. She said he is usually armed. The case was forwarded to the Prosecutor for a warrant.

**Counterfeit/1400 blk W 27th Ave- Complainant** reported a Hispanic female used a fake 20 dollar bill to make a purchase. She left in a pickup. The store manager will try and provide a video of the suspect. The serial number of the bill is MG59940906B.

## CAT

**Weapons/5300 blk W Canal Dr-** Patrol officers and CAT detectives responded to the parking lot for a vehicle that had been shot. The 18 year old female victim was sitting inside her vehicle at the gas pumps when she heard something hit her car. The victim got out and looked at an unknown make/model gray or silver minivan that was parked at the gas pumps next to her. The victim could see smoke inside the van and the Hispanic female driver had a very surprised look on her face. The victim said the Hispanic female suspect looked at her, and flipped her off. The victim said the van quickly drove out of the parking lot, and southbound on Edison St. The area was checked by responding officers, but the van wasn't located. The van was occupied by the Hispanic female driver, black male passenger and an unknown person in the back seat. The victim said she didn't have any previous encounters with the occupants of the minivan.

It is unknown what the suspects were doing with a gun out, but at this point this appears to be an accidental discharge.
