Friday, August 12, 2016

D Squad

Auto Theft/8700 W Falls Ave- Complainant reported that an unknown suspect took her black 2006 Chevrolet Avalanche. There no keys in the vehicle. The vehicle has a cracked windshield, chrome wheels and there is a pink zip tie holding the tailgate handle on the tailgate. The vehicle was entered as stolen.

Auto Theft/2600 blk W Kennewick Ave- Complainant reported that they had repossessed a silver 2007 Dodge Ram 1500 pickup and it was at the above location. Today she went to have the vehicle detailed and it was gone. The vehicle was entered as stolen.

Domestic/2000 blk W 4th Ave- Male and female were arguing. Both denied anything physical took place.

B-Shift

Identity Theft/100 blk N Ely- Employees reported a suspicious male attempting to use a fraudulent ID. Employees reported that the suspect entered the store and attempted to purchase two cell phones on an account belonging to a male in North Carolina. When the account was checked there was a fraud alert on it. Contact was made with the suspect who stated he was the male and provided an obviously forged ID. The suspect was eventually identified out of New York. Post Miranda he advised that he had purchased the victim information on Craigslist. He was booked for identity theft.

Arson/4200 blk W Klamath Ave- Complainant reported that this evening his wife found their flower pot containing plastic flowers on fire near the front porch. He said this is

the second time someone has lit a fire in the pot since June. An area canvass did not locate any witnesses or suspects.

Ambulance Assist/ 200 blk W Kennewick Ave- Officers responded to assist KFD with a female who had passed out at the bar. The security officer believed that the female may have had her drink laced with some type of drug. Contact was made with the female who was transported to Trios. She was too intoxicated to be interviewed and the ER did not have blood results back at this point. Medical staff believes she was just intoxicated but follow up will be completed by Dayshift.

Auto Theft/500 blk E Bruneau Ave- Officers responded to a report of an auto theft in progress. Witnesses observed two males enter a Camaro for sale and begin to drive it off. The vehicle went a short distance and then stopped. Two males attempted to run from the vehicle but one was detained by witnesses. The other two juvenile suspects were returned to the scene by parents when they learned of the incident. Post Miranda one of the subjects stated that he wanted the Camaro but did not have money to buy it. He, along with two other subjects burglarized the business and stole the keys to the vehicle. They returned tonight and attempted to steal the car but were unsuccessful since they could not drive a manual transmission. Case forwarded to the Juvenile PA and the juveniles were released to parents.

CAT

Warrant Arrest/1500 blk W 14TH Ave- CAT detectives contacted a male at this location and arrested him for 2 felony warrants. He was booked into Benton County Jail.

Warrant Arrest/1000 blk W 4TH Ave- CAT detectives received information a gang member was inside the apartment. Detectives contacted him and booked him into Benton County Jail for a DOC warrant and Franklin Co. Warrant.

Information/Bruneau & Canal- Male was riding his bicycle in the area and crashed, possibly because of a hose in the road. He was transported to Trios and could not remember the accident. A friend that was riding just ahead of him avoided the hose and then heard the male crash in the area of the hose.

Field Arrest/5200 blk W Clearwater Ave- Male was in a Taxi 1 cab at the back of the store. The vehicle was running, in gear and he had his foot on the break, passed out. He had also thrown up down the front of his shirt and pants. His driver status said he is Suspended in the Third Degree. The owner of the vehicle was contacted and said he

sold the vehicle to Taxi One. Several attempts were made to contact the owner of Taxi 1, but they were not successful. Post Miranda the driver said he had worked all night driving the cab and pulled behind the store to eat. He did not remember falling asleep. He was arrested and booked for DWLS 3rd Degree. The vehicle was left at the location and was most likely towed by the business since it was in the way of the loading area.

B-Shift

Fatality Collision/Kennewick Ave & Conway St- Officers responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian fatality collision. 65 year old male had been at the gas station and was attempting to cross Kennewick Ave on foot southbound. He was not in a cross walk and was struck by an SUV traveling east on Kennewick Ave in the curb lane. He was thrown into the parking lot of restaurant and sustained massive head trauma resulting in his death. The female driver of the SUV had just finished her shift. She was checked and showed no signs of impairment. Sgt Newton and patrol handled the investigation.

Sunday, August 14, 2016

Auto Theft/700 blk S Gum St- Complainant reported that an unknown suspect took her Tan 1994 Acura Integra. The vehicle is tan but is listed as Burgundy. The hood is multi colored and faded. It has 3 five spoke rims and a generic black rim. There is damage to the left front bumper and fender with red paint transfer. The vehicle was listed as stolen.

Order Violation/700 blk S Irving - Male violated a protection order by attempting to contact his sister at her residence. He fled the scene prior to the officers arriving and could not be located. Family members at the scene do not know where he lives. Case was forwarded for charges.

Vehicle Prowl/2900 blk S Tacoma PI- Officer Valdez responded to a found property report. A small bag of miscellaneous property was found in the gutter. The items indicated it had been from the above location. The resident was contacted and discovered that an unknown suspect ***entered his unlocked vehicle*** and took the property.

Order Violation/100 blk W 1st PI- Complainant reported that his ex-girlfriend and child's mother, violated an order by coming to his place of work. Case forwarded for charges.

B-Shift

Missing Person/7900 blk W 21st Pl- Officer Johnson contacted complainant in reference to his father being missing. He is 81 years old and suffers from dementia. He was last seen at 0900 and when his son returned to the residence and his vehicle was gone. Attempts to contact him by phone were unsuccessful. Officer Johnson and the son worked with his father's credit card company and checked recent transactions. A transaction at a hotel in Cle Elum was located. Law enforcement responded to the hotel and located him and the vehicle. The son was notified and was in route to pick his father up.

Hit and Run/4th Ave & Union St- Complainant reported that she had been traveling east on 4th and stopped for traffic in the roundabout. She was struck from behind by a full size truck. The driver of the truck asked her to pull into the parking lot. She pulled into the lot and the truck drove away eastbound on 4th. No suspect information.

Threats/3700 blk W 48th Ave- Complainant reported that this evening he received four phone calls from the same unknown male threatening to kill him. The caller stated he was sleeping with his girlfriend and knew where he lived. The numbers called from were either disconnected or from out of the country.

Assault & Robbery/3000 blk W 4th Ave- Officers responded to reports of a female yelling for help and some type of struggle was occurring. Prior to police arrival a witness reported that a male had fled on foot from the apartment. Contact was made with a female who reported that her ex-boyfriend had knocked on her door. When she answered he held a knife to her throat and forced his way inside. He assaulted and choked her. He also demanded all of her money. Prior to fleeing he stole a 911 only cell phone and a laptop computer. There is currently a No Contact Order between the two. Officer Kohn responded and a K9 track was completed but the suspect was not located. The victim left the apartment to stay with a friend. As she was driving to Pasco she spotted the suspect near on Kennewick Ave at SR 395. Officers checked the area and the area of the apartment. The suspect was spotted near the apartment and fled again. A second K9 track was completed but he was not located. Case forwarded Prosecutor and continuing to work on locating the suspect.
