**Thursday, October 6, 2016**

### A-Shift

**Warrant Arrest/00 blk N Kent St-** Juvenile requested assistance in picking up a juvenile that just got a warrant issued for a Probation violation. The 16 year old was located, arrested and booked into juvenile.

**Mental/1100 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-** Officers responded for a suspicious male in the store talking to himself and was sporting a small camping hatchet on his belt in full view in some kind of holster. The 36 year old male was cooperative. He appeared to have a mental issue and was trespassed from the store and released.

**Theft from Vehicle/1200 blk N Jefferson St-** Reporting party advised unknown subject **entered her unlocked vehicle** and took stole several items. No other information at this time.

**Taking Motor Vehicle without Permission/2600 blk S Grant Ct-** The owner of a gold/green 2006 Subaru Forester SW advised his distraught 16 year old daughter took his vehicle without permission. An Attempt to Locate (ATL) was put out and later in the day several reports of a reckless gold Subaru with a female driver came out. Officers checked the area and kept missing her. She was later located after she huffed aerosol and crashed into three cars at 4<sup>th</sup> and Union (totaling them). She was taken to Trios for DUI along with several other charges.

**Trespassing Arrest/500 blk S Garfield St-** Officer Littrell was advised by school officials there were two juveniles trespassing on school grounds in the football stadium. Officer Littrell requested A Shift officers to assist him. Both subjects were located and detained after they tried to run away from Officer Littrell. A 16 year old gang member out of Pasco and a 15 year old Kennewick HS student who had been suspended were both arrested for trespassing. The 16 year old also had marijuana in his possession and was booked into Juvenile on a Probation violation. The 15 year old was released to the Vice Principal of Kennewick HS.

## **C-Squad**

**Assault/1100 blk W 10<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Two subjects arrived at this location to repossess a Dodge Charger. The vehicle was in the process of being lifted onto the truck when a female placed their 7 year old daughter in the vehicle so it could not be towed. The two subjects then physically assaulted the tow truck drivers to prevent the vehicle from being towed. One used a box cutter to swing at and intimidate the victims. He was arrested and booked for Assault 2<sup>nd</sup>. The send subject was arrested for Assault 4<sup>th</sup> and released. The vehicle was towed from the scene by the Repo Company.

**Auto Theft/400 blk S Louisiana St-** Complainant reported the theft of her maroon, 2000 Toyota Camry. The vehicle had been parked in front of her house and disappeared sometime in the last 24 hours. The vehicle was entered as stolen.

**Theft/100 blk N Ely St-** Employee stated an \$1800 bike was just stolen and ridden off by the suspect. The suspect walked into the store and took the bike out the front door. The bike is described as an Accell North America, Kato, FS 3 27.5 16" Black and Green "Ghost". The suspect was a white male 6/02 height, 180 lbs, 20 to 25 years old, dark hair over his ears, goat-tee.

**Auto Theft & Recovered/00 blk S Dawes St - Complainant** reported his 1998 black in color two door Honda Civic was stolen from his driveway. It was stolen between the

hours of 1730 and 2000. As the vehicle was being entered into NCIC, it was discovered WSP located it abandoned near Yakima and had it towed. The owner was advised on how to get his car back. No suspects in the case.

***Assault& Trespass Warning/200 blk N Dennis St-*** The bartender reported a fight in the parking lot. Upon arrival a male was located on the ground. He had a bloody lip, black eye and was highly intoxicated. He had been in a fight with a friend. He refused medical attention and did not want to press charges. He was taken home by another friend. The aggressor was trespassed from the bar for 5 years.

## **CAT**

***Trespass/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-*** Mall security requested assistance with trespassing a male that was loitering inside the mall. The suspect apparently caused some minor disturbances inside the mall over the past few days and he was carrying a hatchet on his backpack. Detectives Salter and Riley contacted the male and issued him a 5 year trespass notice from Columbia Center Mall. He appears to have mental health issues and was the same person trespassed from earlier in the day from another nearby business.

***Driving while License Suspended & Warrant Arrest/Canal & Fruitland St-*** CAT detectives observed a male driving with a suspended license. He was stopped and arrested for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2 arrest warrants. The female passenger with him had 2 warrants for her arrest. Both were booked into Benton County Jail.

## **Friday, October 7, 2016**

### **B-Shift**

***Warrant/600 blk S Columbia Center Blvd-*** A parks employee called to report a suspicious male at the park. The employee believed that this male might be responsible for some damage to the bathrooms. Contact was made with the male and he was found to have an outstanding felony warrant. He was interviewed but denied damaging the bathrooms. He was booked and trespassed from all City parks.

***Graffiti/00 blk E Kennewick Ave-*** Employees reported that an unknown suspect tagged one of their vans during the night. The graffiti appears to be in black marker and was illegible. They advised they would handle the cleanup.

***Burglary/400 blk S Quillan Pl-*** Officer Engel contacted complainant in reference to a burglary report. He advised that during an unknown time frame and unknown suspect ***entered his unlocked shed*** and stole four airsoft guns and BB's.

***Death Investigation/Columbia Park Fishing Pond-*** KFD and KPD responded to a report of a vehicle on fire near the family fishing pond. Fire arrived and was able to extinguish the vehicle. A badly burned male body was located in the vehicle. Investigations responded and took over the investigation.

***Graffiti/5000 blk W 24<sup>th</sup> Pl-*** Officer Brakebill responded to the area for graffiti to a fence at this location and graffiti to a walking bridge. The graffiti was not gang related and was documented. KID was contacted and will be handling clean up.

***Theft/800 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-*** Loss prevention detained a female for shoplifting a curling iron. During the search of her purse they located a meth pipe and a small amount of suspected methamphetamine. The narcotics were collected and have been sent to the lab for analysis. She was booked on the theft.

## **D Squad**

***Field Arrest/1400 blk W Kennewick Ave-*** Officer Kiel was checking the area of Olympia and Kennewick Avenue for suspects that had just fled a vehicle that had eluded Officer Grant. The suspect vehicle had been located a short distance from this contact. Officer Kiel saw a male sitting on a bench at the above location and contacted him. The male became verbal as soon as he was contacted saying Officer Kiel had not right to contact him and that he was profiling because he is Hispanic. Officer Kiel explained he was contacting the male due to an investigation of a felony crime and the male got up and started to walk away. The male was detaining and arrested for Obstructing. There was an empty holster on the suspect vehicle. The male's backpack was inventoried and a 72 hour Hold was discovered with the male's name on it. The male was identified and he had 2 felony warrants for his arrest. He was booked for the warrants and charge of obstructing.

***Eluding/Olympia & Kennewick Ave-*** Officer Grant attempted to stop a blue Nissan Maxima for a traffic infraction. The vehicle fled at a high rate of speed and ran a stop sign. Officer Grant terminated the stop. Officer Reil located the vehicle abandoned and the north end of Olympia. Officer Kiel contacted a male in the area which resulted in an unrelated arrest. A male contacted officers in the area and said he had driven a male to a house in Pasco and thought the male might be connected to the officer's efforts. The owner of the vehicle is out of Bremerton and was contacted. He said the vehicle had been impounded several months ago and said it had been towed in Othello. The tow truck driver said he will call tomorrow with the buyer's name. This investigation is ongoing.

## **CAT**

***Reckless Driving/Clearwater & Johnson St-*** Detectives Salter and Riley were near Clearwater Ave and SR 395 when they heard a motorcycle accelerating southbound on SR395. The motorcycle turned on to Clearwater Ave traveling westbound. The motorcyclist quickly accelerated to between 90-100 MPH. The motorcyclist was seen stopping near Clearwater and Morain St at a gas station where the 49 year old male driver was cited for no motorcycle endorsement and Reckless Driving. His motorcycle was towed per Washington State Law for not having a motorcycle endorsement.

## **Saturday, October 8, 2016**

### **B-Shift**

***Assault of a Child/1000 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-*** Officers responded to a disturbance at this location. Upon arrival no one immediately answered the door. A female eventually came to the door and was covered in blood. She was immediately removed from the residence and officers then detained a male who also had blood on him. Officers located a 6 year old male in the shower covered in blood. The adult male eventually admitted to hitting the child and causing a laceration to his scalp. The child was transported to Trios and later admitted for injuries to the head. Officers located additional injuries to the child. A search warrant was obtained for the residence and evidence was collected. The adult male was booked into the jail for assault 2<sup>nd</sup> of a child and a no contact order was issued between him and the two children living at the apartment. CPS responded and took the child into protective custody. Case forwarded to CID for assistance in a Kids Haven interview.

***Auto Theft/800 blk W Klamath Ave-*** Complainant reported that her son's girlfriend stole her vehicle on 10/7/16. She awoke from a nap and found the female, the vehicle and keys to the vehicle gone. 1993 GMC pickup entered as stolen.

### **D Squad**

***Assault with a Weapon/400 blk W 1<sup>st</sup> Ave-*** Officer Grant responded to Lourdes's Hospital in Pasco. Male reported that another male stabbed him with a knife. The two were arguing over a bicycle light in the bathroom when the victim was stabbed in the lower left abdomen with a 4 inch blade. The residence was checked for the suspect but he was not located. A second location was also checked as the suspect had been sleeping there and he was not located there either. An ATL was broadcast for the suspect and the vehicle he is most likely in, a lime green 1976 Ford Van.

***Assault DV/1300 blk W 7<sup>th</sup> Pl-*** Officer Kiel responded. Female reported that her boyfriend assaulted her several times at the location. She said he stood over her and was stabbing the wall and told her she does not deserve to live. He has pending charges for assaulting her last month. She made a report with Richland PD tonight concerning

him assaulting her there. A search warrant was obtained for the above location for evidence of the assault and the suspect. He was located and was taken into custody without incident. Another male was at the location and was arrested for a felony warrant.

## **Sunday, October 9, 2016**

### **B-Shift**

***Theft/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-*** Store security observed male concealing items in his pants. He then exited the store without paying and was detained. He admitted to the theft and was found to have side cutters concealed in his pants as well. He stated that he is a heroin user and does not currently have a home. He was arrested and booked for theft.

***Burglary/2400 blk W Klamath Ave-*** Property is currently for sale and has been vacant for over one year. Most of the property is out of the house; however a few items are being stored in the garage. Owner came to Kennewick today to collect those items, as the house has a new owner moving in. She discovered that a Chicago brand Miter saw and a Craftsman Weed Wacker were missing from the garage. The house was searched and examined, however there is no indication of forced entry. No suspects or witnesses at this time.

***Trespass & Resisting Arrest/300 blk N Ely St-*** Officer Rosane responded in reference to a female refusing to leave a room at check-out time. Contact was made with the female who advised that she had paid for the room and was not leaving. Officers checked her paperwork which showed she had not paid for additional nights. She was told to exit the room and she refused. She then became confrontational and attempted to hit an officer. She was arrested for trespass and resisting arrest. While being escorted to a patrol vehicle she threatened to jump over a stair railing and take the officer with her. Once at the patrol vehicle she began slamming her head against the car. She was booked for trespass and resisting arrest.

***Malicious Mischief/4200 blk W Clearwater Ave-*** Officer Rosane contacted the complainant in reference to a vandalism report. She advised she had left her vehicle parked in the parking lot overnight. When she returned this morning she found the windows had been broken out and there was a large dent in the body. She believes her husband's ex-wife is responsible. There is video at the location and she is in the process of retrieving it.

### **D Squad**

**Assault DV/2000 blk W 5<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Male hit a female because he was jealous. He was booked for Assault-DV.

**Failure to Supervise/4200 blk W 27<sup>th</sup> Ave -** Female left her two children 1 and 3 years old alone for 30 minutes while she went to the store for alcohol. She was medically cleared at Trios for booking. She was booked at the Benton County Jail for Failure to Supervise.

**Assault DV/7700 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Female hit and pushed her boyfriend when he told her he had informed his family she had cheated on him. She was booked for Assault 4 DV.


