**Friday, December 9, 2016**

### **A Shift**

***Graffiti/900 blk W Klamath Ave-*** Complainant advised unknown subject spray painted on his commercial fence. He advised he would clean it up.

***Internal Theft/7700 blk W Deschutes Ave-*** Assistant Store Manager was caught on video stealing over \$400 worth of lottery tickets. The store manager is writing up the details and working on getting us the taped footage from their CCTV system. Officer Quinioes is handling the follow-up.

***Warrant Arrest Attempt/1100 blk N Buchanan St-*** Several officer's responded reference a tip a wanted male was there and had multiple outstanding warrants for his arrest. As officers arrived, the suspect fled out the back half-dressed and ran across the field north of the RR tracks, disappearing into the apt area on Cleveland St. Police K-9 was called

out and a track followed the trail to 900 blk S. Cleveland. The apt was searched and the suspect was not located.

## **C Shift**

**Auto Theft/Columbia Park-** Complainant left her vehicle in the parking area of the Edison boat launch overnight due to mechanical issues. She returned today and the vehicle was gone. We checked tow logs and PD call logs and did not show the car had been removed. The vehicle is a 1990 blue Ford Aerostar minivan with a temporary tag in the window. The van has been entered as stolen.

**Community Care Fund/3800 blk Plaza Way-** Couple live in Umatilla and they had traveled to Trios for a medical issue with the husband that required surgery. He was discharged this evening; however their car would not start. They have limited means and earliest family could arrive to assist was Sunday. Trios called looking for assistance. The couple was provided a room for the night next to Trios.

**Warrant Arrest/Canal & Quincy-** Officers responded to reports of a male walking on the roadway screaming and interfering with traffic. Officers contacted the male who had three felony warrants. He was booked on the warrants.

## **Saturday, December 10, 2016**

### **A Shift**

**Burglary/200 blk S Benton St-** An unknown suspect entered an enclosed outdoor patio by cutting the screen door and stole an artificial decorated 5 foot Christmas tree that was on display.

**Welfare Check/800 blk E 1st Ave-** Officers responded to a call of a female passed out face down in the roadway. The 40 year old female appeared to be under the influence and it was obvious she was hypothermic and needed immediate medical assistance. Officers used a blanket to keep her warm until medics arrived to take over and transport her to Trios for treatment. She was unable to give a statement. No sign of foul play.

**Graffiti/100 blk W 1st Ave-** Unknown suspect tagged with red and black spray paint on the business. GAP notified.

**Auto Theft/1000 blk W 4th Ave-** Complainant advised his silver 2 door Honda Civic was stolen. No leads.

### **C Shift**

***Shoplift/800 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-*** Loss Prevention reported that a male suspect stole a pair of shoes from the store. They had decent video showing the suspect, so photo posted to Face Book seeking identification help.

***Assault/7000 blk W Grandridge Blvd-*** Security staff during the hockey game contacted a 52 year old man, who was intoxicated and causing a disturbance due to his aggressive behavior and foul language. As security tried to escort him out of the building, he punched one of the security staff in the face. He was handcuffed by security. Officers working the game arrived and took him into custody. He was cited for assault, trespassed, and released to a sober friend.

***Auto Theft/1000 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-*** Male started his 2007 Pontiac G6 to warm it up. He went back inside for just a minute, in which time it was stolen. Dispatch put out an ATL to all local agencies and a short time later Pasco PD located the car. Suspects fled from the vehicle and were apprehended. Arrested were a 30 year old male and a 23 year old female. They advised that they had come up from Oregon in a stolen gray Honda 4dr. They said that dumped that car and stole the Pontiac. We checked the area of 1000 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> and did not locate the Honda. Both were booked by Pasco PD for possession of stolen property.

***Auto Theft/400 blk N Washington-*** Female heard her 2002 Chrysler Sebring start, which was parked under the carport of her residence. She went outside and the car was gone. She immediately called to report the theft. The car was most likely left unlocked, and she has her keys to the car. Officers checked the surrounding area and located the car in the 300 block of West Grand Ronde. It was unoccupied and no evidence to indicate who had stolen it. The car was released back to her.

## **Sunday December 11, 2016**

### **A Shift**

***Suicide Attempt/4800 blk W 9th Ave-*** 34 year old female depressed due to a recent child death took pills while drinking beer. She voluntarily was transported to Trios for evaluation, Crisis was notified.

### **C Shift**

***Warrant Arrest/00 blk N Sheppard Pl-*** As part of a domestic assault investigation Officers contacted a male at the apartment. He was arrested and booked on a felony and 2 misdemeanor warrants. The DV investigation sent to City Attorney for review on charging.

**Burglary/100 blk E Columbia Dr-** At 19:25 Officers responded to an alarm activation in the yard with two subjects being seen on video. The suspect's foot prints in the snow showed that they had fled jumping a fence. It appeared that they had been in the process of trying to remove large spools of wire, but were unsuccessful.

**Field Contact/3100 blk W Clearwater-** Officers contacted a transient male who had overstayed his welcome in the bathrooms of two restaurants. One business reported possible narcotic use by the male in their bathroom and the other business was not able to close as he had locked himself in their bathroom. He was trespassed from both locations.

**Burglary/7500 blk W Deschutes PI-** Officers responded to an alarm at the location at 19:52hrs that had received multiple trips. They arrived and saw a subject inside the location. The male was called out and surrendered under threat of Taser application. He had entered the location **through an unsecured basement door**. He is transient and had left his backpack and other property just outside the door. His story was that he was just looking for a warm place to sleep. Officer Kohn/K9 responded and the building was cleared. It did not appear that anyone else had been with him. Per the on call Prosecutor, the male was charged with trespassing.

**Warrant Arrest/3800 blk Plaza Way-** Male had gone to Trios for treatment for facial injuries sustained from falling due to his intoxication. While at Trios he became aggressive with staff resulting in them calling for police assistance to ensure they were not assaulted. He had a KPD warrant for interrupting a medical facility. He was medically cleared and booked on his warrant.

**Field Contact/Columbia Park-** Officer Davis contacted a 30 year old male who advised he was playing Pokemon Go. He was warned about being in the park after hours.

**Stolen Auto Recovery/2000 blk W 19<sup>th</sup>-** The stolen green 1995 Honda Accord that was reported on 12/06 was recovered by Utah State Patrol this evening. They had arrested a male who was driving the vehicle. He has history here locally and a current KPD warrant. Utah was charging him with possession of stolen property. Registered owner was notified of the recovery.
