Friday, January 6, 2017

C- Shift

Vehicle Prowl/2700 blk S Morain Pl- Complainant reported that his work truck was entered during the night. The truck should have been locked when parked at his residence. The doors were left open after the theft. Taken were some miscellaneous items and a laptop computer. The Toshiba laptop has a distinct "Pillar to Post" business sticker on the top of it that covers the entire top. There are no suspects.

Auto Theft/200 blk S Washington- Complainant started her 1996 Ford Crown Victory to let it warm up. **She left the door unlocked and went back inside her residence.** The car was stolen. BCSO located the car a short time later and pursued it around 27th Ave just east of the City. BCSO terminated the pursuit once the suspect began driving reckless. The stolen car was located several hours later by BCSO in the 1500 blk S Bermuda Rd. The suspect tracks in the snow were followed to a detached garage in the area. BCSO arrested the suspect.

Warrant Arrest/5200 blk W Clearwater- Officers responded to information that a 29 year old female was at the location. She was arrested on a misdemeanor theft warrant.

A-Shift

Malicious Mischief/100 blk N Union- Officers responded to the location for a malicious mischief that had just occurred. Contact was made with employee who advised he was in the rear of the location dumping trash when a male subject ran up to the back door of the business and painted a 5point star with a circle around it. He chased the subject who ran to the front of the business. The suspect then ran east from the location and was not located. The suspect was described as a white male 35 to 40 wearing a facemask and jacket.

Threats/1000 blk N Colorado- Officers responded to the location for a threats report. Contact was made with manager who explained that an ex-employee called the location numerous times cursing at the employees who answered the phone and made vague threats. On his final phone call he told the employee that he was going to kill one of the employees. Richland PD attempted to contact the suspect at his residence but there was no answer. This is the second report filed by reference the suspect.

Theft/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Officers contacted an employee by phone who advised he works at a kiosk in the mall. He sat two brand new iPad's on the counter before he got busy and left them there for approximately 1 hour. When he went to retrieve them, one was missing. No suspects.

Assault/2700 blk S Quillan St- Officers responded to an assault. The male victim advised that he was confronted by a male in the parking lot of the location. The male is the ex-boyfriend of a female the victim is currently seeing. The suspect punched him several times and slammed his head into the bumper of a vehicle before getting into a waiting vehicle. Suspect was not located.

Fugitive from Justice/00 blk S Kent- Officers responded to the location for a disturbance. Contact was made with a female and male. Disturbance was found to be verbal only. The male had an extraditable warrant for felony assault out of Texas. He was booked for fugitive from justice.

CAT

Warrant Arrest/900 blk W Entiat Ave- CAT detectives were on extra patrol near this residence when they observed a 47 year old female enter the house. She was contacted and arrested on two warrants. She was booked into Benton County Jail.

Warrant Arrest/2700 W Kennewick Ave- CAT detectives were on extra patrol in the area when they observed a 26 year old male. He was contacted and arrested on two warrants. He was booked into Benton County Jail.

C-Shift

Domestic Assault/1900 blk W 4th PI- Officers responded to an open 911 call where dispatch heard a female say 'let go of my throat'. Occupants did not answer the door, which was breached. A male who has 7 previous order violation convictions, was inside with a female. He had obviously assaulted the female and she had bruised and swelling eye. He would not allow her to answer the door and prevented her call to 911. There

was a valid protection order in place. He was booked on felony order violation, assault DV, unlawful imprisonment, and interfering with reporting DV. Apartment management was contacted and handled immediate repair of the door.

Graffiti/300 blk W Entiat Ave- The business reported graffiti done in black marker on their building wall and to a dumpster. There are no suspects.

Warrant Arrest/2700 blk S Quillan St- Officers contacted a male in reference to being involved in a disturbance. He was arrested on a local misdemeanor warrant.

A-Shift

Stolen Vehicle Recovery/1300 blk W 13th Ave- Officers assisted Pendleton, Oregon Police by looking for a blue 2002 Isuzu Trooper SUV that had been reported stolen. They advised us the suspect might be headed to the area of 13th and Olympia St. We located the vehicle and with the help of the newly fallen snow, tracked the suspects' foot prints from the parked vehicle to a nearby apartment. We contacted a 43 year old male who was arrested for several outstanding warrants. We also interviewed him about the auto theft and advised Pendleton PD of that information. At this time he was booked into jail only on the warrants.

Trespass/2700 blk W Kennewick Ave- Prolific male transient was trespassed from this location after refusing to leave when told to by employees.

Trespass/100 blk S Ely St- Same male, who had previously been trespassed from this location, came back and refused to leave. He was arrested and booked into jail for trespassing.

Warrant Arrest/500 blk W Columbia Dr- The clerk called in a male sleeping outside in the snow. He was contacted and arrested for an outstanding warrant. He was taken to Trios for a medical evaluation then booked into jail.

C Shift

Hit & Run/10th & Ely- Officers assisted numerous stuck motorists and responded to several collisions once the snow started to fall. This included contacting a female driver who was at 10th & Ely when she was struck from behind. The suspect then drove around her and fled the scene. The suspect vehicle was a green older box style van. Due to the snow a plate was not obtained. Suspect not located.

A Shift

Robbery/3600 blk W Clearwater Ave- The clerk called in to report he was robbed at 2236 hrs. The clerk advised the robber approached him wearing a white handkerchief over his face and implied he had a gun in his pocket, told the clerk to give him the cash from the register, and **apologizing** by saying he has to pay his rent. We attempted a track using PPD's K-9. The track lost steam eventually a few blocks east along Clearwater.
