Friday, January 13, 2017

D- Shift

B-Shift

Theft & Narcotics/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Loss prevention detained a male after he attempted to exit the store with merchandise he did not pay for. He also had an outstanding warrant and was in possession of heroin. He was arrested and booked.

Warrant Service/4600 blk W Clearwater Ave- Female attempted to shoplift and was detained by loss prevention. She also had an outstanding DOC warrant. She was arrested and booked.

Malicious Mischief/1200 blk W 10th Ave- Complainant reported that an unknown suspect threw an object through the front window of his apartment. The area as checked but the suspect was not located.

Burglary/900 blk W 5th Ave- Complainant reported she and her boyfriend had been out. Upon returning home they found that an unknown suspect had entered the residence and stole a pair of Beats headphones and jewelry. It appears that the ***rear door of the residence was left unsecured.*** Officer Engel was able to locate some footprints which were photographed.

Burglary/700 blk S lone St- Officer Engel contacted complainant regarding a burglary report. It appears that the same suspects from the above case entered the residence ***through an unsecured door.*** The suspects stole a cell phone and computer. Foot prints were located at this scene which matched the previous burglary.

Robbery/1100 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Loss prevention observed two females conceal items on their persons and then exit the store without paying. A loss prevention officer contacted the females and one of them struck loss prevention in the throat and then fled. Photos of the suspects were placed on Facebook and we received information identifying one of the suspects. Investigation continuing.

Hit & Run/10th & Dayton- Officers responded to a hit and run which occurred near 10th and Dayton. A full size truck struck another truck and trailer parked on the south side of the street. A witness followed the suspect vehicle to 34th and Jean where it parked. Officer Engel contacted and arrested a male for hit and run.

Saturday, January 14, 2017

D-Shift

Warrant Arrest/2800 blk W 10th Ave- Officers responded for a report of a male that was refusing to get up, as he was lying on the floor inside the foyer area. During the contact, the male provided a false name, knowing that he had a valid arrest warrant. His identity and the warrant were confirmed, he was booked at the BCSO Jail for the warrant and false reporting.

Warrant Arrest/1100 blk W 10th- Officers responded for a report that a male was making suicidal statements. A record check revealed three valid warrants for his arrest. During the contact, he stated he was going crazy and wanted help. He was arrested on his warrants and booked at the BCSO Jail. CRISIS was notified.

Theft/5100 Blk W 7th Ave- A custom Lion carving awaiting delivery to a customer was taken from the bed of a truck. No leads or suspects.

Warrant Arrest/1100 blk W 10th Ave- Officers received information that a wanted male had warrants and was at the location. He was contacted and arrested without incident.

Assault 2nd DV/1000 blk W 4th Ave- Male was arrested for assault 2nd DV after he held a knife to his girlfriend's neck and forced her out of the apartment. Officers located the male outside of his apartment and found him to be armed with an axe type garden tool. He was compliant and detained without incident. The knife was recovered and entered in evidence. He was placed on a 72hr hold and booked at the BCSO Jail.

B-Shift

Noise Violation/600 blk N Arthur St- Officers responded to a party complaint at this apartment. Two different complainants advised that the party had been ongoing for hours and was keeping their children awake. Contact was made with the renter who

had been warned the previous week regarding noise. He was arrested and booked on the noise violation and his dozen party goers were dispersed.

Sunday, January 15, 2017

D Shift

Trespass Warning/3600 blk W Clearwater Ave- Officers responded for a male that was asking employees if they were worried about anything happening in the store, or being robbed, and also making statements that, if they did not know who he was, they would soon enough. Contact was made and management requested that the male be trespassed. He was contacted and issued a trespass warning for 5 years.

Civil Child Custody/600 blk S Morain- Officers responded for two females arguing in the intersection. On arrival mother and her 14 year old daughter were found yelling at each other. Investigation revealed a convoluted child custody matter between the mother and ex-husband, who is currently in work release at BCSO. During the investigation, mother stated that the daughter lives with her and always has. The girls' grandmother stated the 14 year old lives with her father, and that she has been living with and caring for her granddaughter since her son was incarcerated in April of 2016. At the time of the lengthy contact, no involved parties could provide any court orders to establish custody. As the investigation progressed, after several hours, mom advised Officers to allow her daughter to go with her grandmother.

B-Shift

DUI Collision/2400 blk W 36th Ave- Officer Sneyd responded to a two vehicle collision at this location. Second vehicle was traveling east on 36th and was slowing to turn into a driveway on the south side of the roadway. They were struck in the rear by first vehicle and the driver appeared intoxicated. He was arrested for DUI.

Theft/1100 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Complainant reported she had been shopping and her cell phone and wallet were stolen from her cart. The wallet contained two credit cards. Loss prevention checked their cameras but did not observe the theft.

Graffiti/1000 blk W 10th Ave- An unknown suspect tagged a sign on the fence of Park MS. The suspect used black paint. GAP has been notified for clean-up.

Warrant Service/2700 blk S Quillan St- Loss prevention called to report a male was in the store in violation of a criminal trespass warning. He was contacted inside and was arrested for criminal trespass and an outstanding warrant.

Monday, January 16, 2017

Auto Theft/9000 blk W Rio Grande- Reporting party was out of state when Pasco PD called him regarding his 2011 Audi abandoned in their city. He requested they tow it which they did. When he returned the car smelled strongly of gas so he reported it stolen from his driveway. No suspects.

Weapons/1400 blk W 2nd Ave- Male was cleaning his Glock and when he pulled the trigger it fired a round through his house exterior wall into the ground. Nobody was injured.

Hit and Run/2800 blk W 10th Ave – Reporting party parked his car around 10:00 in the parking lot and when he returned he found his quarter panel had been damaged. No suspects.

Warrant Arrest/800 blk W Klamath Ave- Complainant called dispatch to report she thinks her 20 year old daughter is the victim of a DV. She is staying with her 20 year old boyfriend. While in route a records check showed he had an outstanding warrant. Upon arrival it was determined there was no assault DV. He was arrested for the warrant and booked into jail.
