Tuesday, January 17, 2017

C- Shift

C-Shift assisted with numerous motorists assists today mainly getting the vehicles out of the snow.

Warrant/1100 blk W 10th Ave- Male was contacted on an earlier disturbance and gave a false name. His real identity revealed 4 warrants. Officer Trujillo returned to the residence with a search warrant. The door was breached and the male was located hiding under a crib.

Fraud/200 Blk Vista Way- A male with a fake California ID card cashed a counterfeit check at a local business. The California ID card used matched the description of the suspect.

Graffiti/10th & Kingwood- Unknown suspect spray painted on the side of a box van.

Theft/2800 blk W Clearwater Ave- Male stole alcohol from the store and fled. He was located and booked.

A-Shift

Icy rain and sleet most of the shift, street Department was out.

Warrant Arrest/2400 blk W 4th Ave- Officers arrested a 22 year old male for an outstanding Pasco warrant without incident after receiving a tip from Pasco PD he was there.

Shoplift/1300 blk W 4th Ave- 17 year old male was detained by store Loss Prevention for shoplifting. He was released to her parent and referred for theft to Prosecutors office.

Prescription Fraud/100 blk N Ely- Officer Melone got information reference a female suspect who used a fraudulent prescription to order narcotic medication. This case may relate to one that D-Shift was working on. The female was identified and information sent to CID for review.

Wednesday, January 18, 2017

D-Shift

Fire Assist/1st Ave & Washington- Officer Kiel checked out with a vehicle fire. When he notified dispatch they reported that KFD was already in route. The vehicle was already evacuated. The officers assisted with traffic control.

Counterfeit/4500 blk W 27th Ave- The manager reported that they received a counterfeit 50 dollar bill. The bill appeared to be a washed 5 dollar bill and displayed the serial number of MF39856530A. The manager said they have no information concerning who gave them the bill, but said they received it last week.

B-Shift

Mental/5500 blk W Hildebrand- Officer Johnson responded to this residence for a suicide attempt. Female was intoxicated and cut her arm with a knife. She was transported to Trios for stitches and evaluation by Crisis Response.

Assist Fire/1800 blk S Washington St- KPD and KFD responded to a report of a vehicle on fire in the parking lot. The vehicle had been parked at the location for a few days and a fire started under the hood near the battery. KFD could not find any evidence of arson and the hood was completely latched shut when units arrived.

Harassment/500 blk S Delaware St- Officer Hanson contacted complainant in reference to a harassment report. She advised that today she received an email from the account of her ex-husband. The email contained an explicit photo and the email stated that if she did not apologize the photo would be sent to numerous people. Initial report completed and contact was made with law enforcement in Nevada to assist. The lives in this jurisdiction and they will be attempting to interview him regarding the case.

Assault/300 blk S Sheppard St- Complainant reported that he had been sitting in his vehicle in the driveway of this residence when a male walked up to the window and attempted to strangle him. He said that he pulled his handgun and pointed it at the suspect to get him away. He advised that as he drove away he believes the suspect pointed a gun at him. Officer Howard responded to the residence and spoke with a male. He reported the complainant was at the location and accusing him of stealing

items. He grabbed the complainant by the jacket to get his attention and the complainant pulled a gun on him. The male advised that he was unwilling to be a victim. Case forwarded to the Prosecutor for review.

Thursday, January 19, 2017

D Shift

Community Care Fund- Sergeant Jackson was off duty and became aware of a juvenile male that was wearing boots too small for him and the boots had holes in them. Sergeant Jackson contacted Officer Reil who met Sergeant Jackson and the male at Ranch and Home. There they bought him a new pair of boots and 2 pairs of socks. The Ranch and Home owner donated a pair of socks and waterproofing for the boots.

Information/00 blk E 1st Pl- Officer Kiel responded to a Welfare Check concerning a 40 year old male. He was on the ground flopping around and said he was going to prison tomorrow for raping a 17 year old girl in Gig Harbor Washington. Gig Harbor police was contacted and they did not have any rapes that matched his claims. The male lives in Walla Walla so Walla Walla SO was contacted. They did not have any rapes that matched his claims. The deputy said that the male lives in a trailer park where there is a lot of Meth use.

Aggravated Assault/2000 blk W 2nd Ave- Several officers responded to a report of an infant child taken at gun point after two women broke into the residence. The investigation determined that a female and her boyfriend were involved in a mutual combative domestic assault where injuries occurred. Officers attempted to make contact but were unable to do so. The female later returned to the location after the initial assault to retrieve their child in common. There was a knife involved and an alleged firearm during the second contact. A suspected vehicle was located by Pasco PD. The female was taken to jail on a warrant. The child was turned over the father. After the search warrant of the vehicle is completed, the case will be sent up for review.

Weapons Violation/16th Ave & Garfield St- Officers responded to the area after a complaint in which two males had been arguing with a third party and a gun was implied. Two 17 year old males were contacted. A look alike pistol (Airsoft gun) was located concealed on one of the juveniles. A brass knuckle type knife was concealed on the other. Further investigation revealed that one of the 17 year olds went to sell male marijuana oil and did not pay due to a civil disagreement. He allegedly showed a firearm while in his house to the two 17 year olds in response to one of them having the look alike pistol. Investigation ongoing.

Order Violation/400 blk W 11th Ave- Complainant alleged that an order was being violated at the location in which the boyfriend of the mother was around the 7 year old child. It was determined that there was some confusion on the issuance of the order. He was served again and then left the location. Sent to City Attorney for review.

Trespass/3700 blk W 19th Ct- Complainant alleged that his ex-girlfriend entered the location when she was retrieving her child in common without permission. Case sent to city attorney for review.

Armed Robbery/300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Several KPD officers responded to the area for a report of a male entering the location and pointing a gun at employees. The suspect fled towards the Center Pointe Apartments where a K9 track ensued and an apartment building was contained. A suspect was identified and located a couple of hours after the initial incident driving. Two suspects were detained. This is an ongoing investigation.

B-Shift

Warrant Service/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Officer Johnson responded for a possible shoplift. Loss prevention was watching a female and an unknown male selecting numerous pieces of merchandise. She had three outstanding warrants so Officer Johnson contacted her. She attempted to walk away and then attempted to pull away from Officer Johnson when he was handcuffing her. She was arrested and booked on the outstanding warrants and resisting arrest.
