Friday, January 20, 2017

C- Shift

Trespass/3500 blk W Hood Ave- Female was evicted from the location. Management requested she be trespassed which she was.

Harassment/5100 blk W Clearwater Ave- Complainant broke off a relationship with a male living outside of Washington State. He posted nude photos of her on her Facebook and her employer's Facebook. His whereabouts are unknown.

Urinating in Public/200 blk Vista Way- Male defecated outside the premises. He was cooperative and promptly cleaned up his mess. Cited and Released.

Trespass/Columbia Park East Boat Launch- Male was located sleeping in a restroom stall this morning. He was cited and released since he had previously been trespassed from the park.

Warrant/2800 blk W Clearwater Ave- Male was at the location passed out drunk. When the staff tried to wake him he screamed something about Donald Trump and refused to leave. He had a warrant and was booked.

Theft/3000 blk W Kennewick Ave – Complainant from the business reported a security camera was stolen from the exterior of the building. The suspect, on the video, an unknown White male wearing a black coat and stocking cap is briefly seen manipulating the camera with a cane before the video stops.

A-Shift

Theft/1300 blk W 4th Ave- Officers responded to the location for a shoplift in progress. Upon arrival they assisted employees with detaining a male. Store employees witnessed him take beef jerky into the bathroom where he ate it. He then walked

through the store taking multiple food items and placing them into his pockets. Arrested and booked.

Malicious Mischief/400 blk W 16th Ave- Male called 911 to file a threats report. He advised he was having problems with another member of the group home where he resides and didn't want to return. He is a ward of the state and was taken back to the group home. Once inside he kicked a bedroom door shattering the door jam. He was placed into custody and taken to transitions.

DUI/4th & Vancouver- Officers responded to the location for a vehicle that was stopped in the middle of the road and a subject slumped over the wheel. The reporting party stated the vehicle had been there for over 30 minutes. Officers arrived and were able to wake the male driver. The vehicle was still in drive and when he woke up he took his foot off the break. The vehicle travelled about 10 feet before he could figure out how to get it to stop. He was placed into custody for DUI.

Assault DV/9200 blk W Gage- Officers responded to the location for a disturbance. Several people were at the location for a party when a male and his girlfriend got into a physical altercation. Both were extremely intoxicated and uncooperative. Witnesses at the location all stated that they got into a verbal argument and the female slapped the male knocking him to the ground. He had a small cut on his lip and scratches to his neck. She was arrested and booked for assault dv.

Fraud/7500 blk W Canal Dr -Complainant was selling a refrigerator on Craigslist when he was tricked into cashing a check from a "buyer" and sending them back some of the money as shipping costs. Forwarded to Detectives.

Graffiti/100 blk W Kennewick Ave- Spray paint was located on three businesses in the downtown area. GAP notified.

Theft/1700 blk S Union St- An unknown suspect drove a white colored Chevy Tahoe to the location and hooked up to a 2015 Triton Cargo trailer containing two Polaris snowmobiles. Video shows a male driving away in the car and appears to be a Hispanic male. Investigation continuing.

Attempted Burglary/4800 blk W Clearwater Ave- Complainant found her front door breached which destroyed the jamb. Her Pitt Bull was inside and she suspects the dog scared the suspects away. No suspects.

Graffiti/1100 blk E 10th Ave- Spray painted in red all over the gazebo. Parks will clean it up. No suspects.

Malicious Mischief/1100 blk W 10th Ave- Complainant found her driver's side mirror broken off and the work "HO" keyed on the driver's side door. No suspects.

A-Shift

Vehicle vs Pedestrian Collision- At 6:20pm on W 4th just east of Tacoma St a 40 year old male, was standing in the westbound lane of W 4th was struck by the 39 year old driver of a westbound Hyundai SUV that did not see him standing in the road. The injured male was attempting to help a friend get her vehicle unstuck and out of her icy/snowy driveway when he was hit. He was transported to Trios with a head and elbow/shoulder injury. The driver of the SUV was not injured and the investigation showed he was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Officer Cooper was called out to lead this investigation. 4th Ave between Vancouver and Rainer was closed for several hours.

Warrant Arrest/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Officers were advised of a wanted person, a 31 year old male, was in the store and had multiple warrants for his arrest. He was located, arrested and booked into jail.

DV Assault Arrest/9200 blk W Gage Blvd- 22 year old female was arrested for assault DV against her roommate.

DV Assault Arrest/5500 blk W Hilderbrand- 24 year old male was arrested for assaulting his 20 year old live in girlfriend. He fled the apt before officers arrived but was located in his vehicle in a parking lot off of Clearwater. He was arrested and booked for DV Assault with a No Contact Order put in place.

DUI & Narcotic Investigation/US 395 & W 19th Ave- Sgt Genack covered WSP on a reckless vehicle sighting. WSP had stopped a blue Chevy pickup truck. A 24 year old male was the sole occupant and driver. He appeared to be under the influence of a narcotic. There was also drug paraphernalia in the vehicle in plain sight. CAT was called to the stop and K-9 Officer Merkl was also contacted and responded. WSP took the male into custody for DUI and CAT started a Narcotics investigation.

Burglary/2000 blk W 6th Ave- Owner of this home reported when he arrived home after being gone for several hours and noticed that someone had **entered his unsecured home** and went through all his draws and closets etc. Items missing included jewelry and a debit card. No other leads on suspects.

Warrant & Shoplift/2300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd- Loss Prevention reported a male/female team had shoplifted in the store and fled outside to a blue Saturn sedan and drove off. Officer Sullivan spotted the vehicle leaving the area and stopped it. A 41 & year old male and 37 year old female inside the vehicle and were the two fleeing shoplifters. Both were arrested and brought back to the stores LP office for paper work and then booked into jail for theft.

Shoplifting Arrest/800 Blk N Columbia Center Blvd- 23 year old female was stopped and detained by LP for stealing items from the store. She was cited and released.

Recovered Stolen/9th & Fir- Officer Zinsli ran a plate on a car that was covered in snow showing it had been sitting there for some time. The car returned to a 94' Acura that was stolen in Kennewick last August. The car was impounded with attempts made to contact the registered owner. The car was unoccupied and there was no evidence to identify any suspects.

Suspicious Circumstance/4100 blk W 7th- The resident called to report a suspicious person in their pasture around one of their horses. They saw a white female near one of the horses. The female left when they yelled at her challenging what she was doing. They checked the horse and found that the female had been cutting the hair off of the horse's tail. It is not known why she would want the hair or what use it would have. The horse was not injured.

Stolen Vehicle Attempt/1100 blk W 10th- Complainant found the passenger side window of his car busted out this morning. The steering column had been damaged in an obvious attempt to steal the car. The vehicle is a 1993 Honda Accord. There are no suspects.

Mental/1200 Blk N Morain Lp- Officers responded to a disturbance where a 15 year old female was threatening to kill herself because she was caught by staff making out with another resident. She broke a ceramic coffee mug and was threatening to use the broken piece to slit her wrist. She was physically resisting the staff, medics and the staff

at Trios until she was soft restrained to the bed by medical staff until Crisis could arrive and evaluate.

Malicious Mischief/4700 blk W 27th Ave- Two or more juveniles were seen running away from the residence after breaking several windows of the complainant's vehicle. Area was checked but no locate. Complainant thought the suspects got into a car parked close to the new Chinook Middle School.

Returned Runaway & Warrant Arrest/1200 blk W 10th Ave- 16 year old female has been a runaway since 12/28/16 and returned home today. Mother notified us and a records check showed an outstanding juvenile warrant. She was booked into jail.
