**Monday, January 23, 2017**

### **D- Shift**

**Vehicle Prowl/11th Ave & Columbia Center Blvd-** Complainant reported that an unknown suspect cut the hinges off a work trailer causing \$300.00 in damage. A lock was also cut off a pickup and \$5,300.00 worth of tools taken. Some of the tools were marked with "DDB Plumbing". Photographs of footprints were taken.

**Suspicious Circumstance/5500 blk W Hildebrand-** Complainant reported a male knocked on her door an hour prior to her calling. She said she has seen the male in a vision before. She said one of the screens had been partially pried off a window. The neighbors were contacted and said they only saw children around the residence. All the screens were intact. She became upset and said the police were doing nothing for her. She called her mother who agreed there was nothing more the police could do and said she would try and calm her down.

**Information/200 blk W 6<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Sergeant Weatherbee contacted a female at the Police Station. She appeared to be tweaking and rambled about several concerns from ISIS to the FBI. She became upset when she was told she had not reported anything the police could investigate and she left in a huff. Crisis Response was contacted and said they have had contact with the female and does suffer from Depression and has a history of Meth use. Crisis Response said when they contacted the female she complained about all the things she talked about during this contact.

### **B-Shift**

**Warrant Service/500 blk S Auburn St-** Officer Brakebill responded to the Post Office in reference to a transient sleeping inside. Contact was made with the male who returned with a DOC warrant. He was arrested and booked. A trespass warning was completed.

**Assault/10th Ave & Olympia St-** Complainant reported that he had been walking in the area when a vehicle pulled up to him and 4 individuals exited. He said that the unknown group began hitting him for approximately 10 minutes and then drove away. He had a few scratches and a couple of red marks on his back. No suspect information.

**Robbery/4400 blk W 10th Ave-** Officers responded to a robbery that had just occurred. The clerk advised that a male entered the store and surprised her as she was working near the coolers. The male demanded money and grabbed toward his waistband, no weapon was displayed. The suspect took money out of both registers along with some cigarettes. The suspect then fled westbound on foot.

**Assault/4900 blk S Washington Pl-** Male and his brother got into an argument over a cell phone charger. During the argument one punched the other in the nose, possibly breaking it. He was arrested and booked into Juvenile for assault 4 DV.

**Burglary/7400 blk W Canal Dr-** Officers responded to an alarm and upon arrival the front door had been broken out and a crowbar was located inside. The building was cleared and no one was located inside. Security video shows a vehicle pulling up to the front door and the suspect breaking in. It appears that the suspect stole multiple sets of hair clippers.

## **Tuesday, January 24, 2017**

### **D-Shift**

**Aggravated Assault/1700 blk S Young-** Complainant reported that he was threatened with a knife in the above area. The suspect is a white male 20 to 30 years old, 6/01 and about 155 pounds. He has tattoos on his hands as well as possible tattoo on the left side of his neck. The suspect also wears a lot of rings and was driving a blue BMW. Several attempts were made to contact the owner of the vehicle but she could not be located. The investigation is ongoing.

**Eluding & Assault 2nd/Columbia Dr & Fruitland-** Officer Grant responded to information that a male with several felony and misdemeanor warrants, and was currently inside the Pawn Shop, driving silver Dodge Ram PU. While responding to the area, Officer Grant saw a matching truck leaving the area, and confirmed the wanted male was the Driver. Officer Grant attempted to stop the vehicle in the parking lot at Columbia Dr and Fruitland. The truck came to a stop and as she approached, the driver threw the truck in reverse and accelerated rapidly toward her. He then fled at a high rate of speed, crossing the Cable Bridge into Pasco. The pursuit was terminated, and was located later in the week. At the time of incident there was a female passenger who also had warrants and she was located as well

**Assault DV/500 blk N Fisher Pl-** Officers responded for a report from a female that she had been assaulted by her boyfriend. On arrival, investigation revealed that she, who has been struggling with meth use for some time now, had actually assaulted him. She was arrested and booked at the BCSO Jail and a temporary no contact order was completed.

**Lewd Conduct/7500 blk W Arrowhead-** Officers responded for a report of a male who had entered the waiting area of the business and began masturbating. Employees told the male to leave and also told him they were calling Police. The male ignored employees and continued to masturbate. At one point, when employees attempted to leave, he blocked their path. Chief Hohenberg and a Richland Officer arrived and the male was caught. The 40 year old male was arrested and booked for Lewd Conduct and Trespassing. Case to be reviewed for unlawful Imprisonment.

**Burglary/00 blk N Cascade St-** Employees reported that someone somehow gained entry into the business over night and attempted entry into the, till and liquor room but were not successful. Point and method of entry not known, no property taken and no leads or suspects.

**Burglary/800 blk N Tweedt-** Complainant stated she exited her apartment a short time to go to the mailbox and when she returned she saw her male neighbor exiting her apartment. She saw him exit her apartment and quickly enter his apartment which is directly across from hers and close the door. She thought it was odd but continued on into her apartment without saying anything to him. She didn't lock her door and that her door is faulty and **she regularly leaves it unsecure**. When she entered her apartment she noticed she left her purse on the couch and decided to check her wallet. She noted that all of her cash that she had in her wallet was now gone. She knew it had to be he neighbor because she just saw him exit her apartment so she went to confront him. Maria spoke with Miguel and he denied taking any money. She told him she had video surveillance in her apartment and that she would be able to review it. He then admitted to taking the money and said that he would return it to her. She stated she did not want him arrested because she got her money back and did not want him in trouble.

**Indecent Exposure/Kennewick-** 16 year old female reported that she got on a Benton Franklin bus at 500 N Dayton St. She said that she sat next to a male that she described as a black male about 20 years old. The male was wearing a green hat with yellow on it, a black sweater, a black shirt, and blue jeans; he also had a thin light beard and mustache. She didn't recognize the male and had no idea who he was. The bus was fairly full so they had to sit next to each other. After about 10 minutes of travel time with several stops. Most people had gotten off of the bus. She said that there were about 3 people left on the bus and that the male had moved to another seat across from her. Now that the male was in another seat she noticed that he began touching himself. The male started masturbating while he was looking at her. She got off of the

bus at the Transfer Station and alerted the driver but the male had already exited and began to run north towards Clearwater Avenue. The area was checked, but the suspect was not located. Transit will be checking the camera system for possible video. Additional investigation to follow.

## **B-Shift**

**Warrant Arrest/3600 blk W Clearwater Ave-** Officers received information a wanted male was at the location. He had four outstanding warrants for his arrest. He was located inside the store and arrested without incident.

**Theft/1100 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-** Loss Prevention observed via camera a female put on a new pair of boots and then exit the store without paying for them. Security camera footage was obtained.

**Missing Child/3000 blk W 4th Ave-** Officers responded to this address for a missing child at 1900 hours. Mother reported that her 5 year old son had not arrived at his daycare provider after leaving school at 1520 hours. After approximately an hour of investigation he was located at his aunt's residence in the same complex. It appears he rode a bus home instead of to the daycare and had been outside for hours. When the aunt arrived home she located him and took him to get something to eat. Report completed and forwarded to CPS for review.

**Burglary/1300 blk W 4th Ave-** A passerby found the front door to the business broken out. It appears the suspect threw a crow bar through the front glass door and entered. The suspect appears to have gone through the cash register and stole cash and lottery tickets.

## **CAT**

**Warrant Arrest/1st & Washington St-** CAT detectives observed a 20year old male and 18 year old female at this location. He was arrested for one warrant and she was arrested for 2 warrants. He was booked into Franklin Co and she was booked into Benton County Jail.

## **C- Shift**

**Assault DV/400 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-** Male and his girlfriend were intoxicated when they got in an argument about him flirting with other girls on Facebook which ended with him pushing her to the ground and grabbing her by the throat. He was booked for DV Assault.

**Field Contact/10<sup>th</sup> & SR-397-** Officer Zinsli contacted three subjects underneath the overpass. All three were homeless and using the overpass as a sleeping area. The contacted included a 27 year old male who was arrested on a misdemeanor warrant and a 41 year old male who was arrested on two felony warrants. Both were booked into BCSO Jail. The female who was with them was advised to leave the property.

**DUI/Canal & Quincy-** Male, who was intoxicated and driving with a suspended license failed to yield while turning left and collided with a vehicle driven by a female, also intoxicated and with a suspended license who suffered a broken wrist as a result of the collision. The male was booked on Vehicular Assault and DWLS. The female was booked on DUI and DWLS.

**Drive by Shooting/2100 blk N Vermont Lp** –Complainant reported finding a bullet hole in his residence. The previous shift had received a shots heard call at about 2am. Complainant had heard the shots at that time but did not call to report it. Officers talked to several residents in the area and found several witnesses that heard 5 shots. There are no known injuries. One witness reported seeing a gray Nissan sedan leaving the area after the shots. When contacted the residents next to the home that was struck were very uncooperative with Officers and made it clear that they did not want us there. It is not known if that was the actual target house. There are no suspects.

**Mental/4800 blk W Clearwater-** Male made suicidal threats at the location. He was transported to Trios where Crisis contacted him.

## **A-Shift**

**Vehicle Prowl/1400 blk W 27<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Male reported that his girlfriend's car was entered while parked and a cell phone stolen. There are no suspects.

**Hit & Run Collision/100 blk E 4th Ave-** 17 year old male committed a hit and run collision on a parked vehicle and the fled the scene. When his parents found out they made him go with them to KPD to report what he did. After being read his rights, he confessed and he was issued several citations and then released to his parents.

## **CAT**

**Warrant Arrest/3100 blk W Kennewick Ave-** CAT detectives observed a 26 year old male walk inside this residence. After a brief standoff he exited and was arrested for a felony warrant. He was booked into Benton County Jail.

**Warrant Arrest/2600 blk W Bruneau Pl-** CAT detectives contacted a 45 year old female in the parking lot. She had a one misdemeanor warrant for her arrest. She was arrested and booked into Benton County Jail.

### C-Shift

**Burglary/00 blk W 10th Ave-** Video shows juveniles wandering around CAT Scan trailer. They opened a panel and found the keys to the trailer. They entered and stole miscellaneous items of low value. Investigation continuing.

**Warrant/7400 blk W Canal Dr-** Employee called reporting a possible fraud in progress where a female was attempting to return stolen merchandise. She has warrants and they are still investigating the theft but could not access the video to confirm the items were stolen. She was booked on her warrants.

**Hit and Run/2700 Blk S Quillan St-** Reporting party found her vehicle had been damaged while parked at the location. The rear driver's side tail light was damaged as was the bumper. No suspects.

**Forgery/4500 blk W 27th Ave-** Complainant found her Debit account had been compromised and a female has cashed several fabricated checks bearing the complainants account number. Forwarded to Investigations.

**Auto Theft/1100 blk W 10th Ave-** Reporting party found his gold 1997 Honda Accord with tinted windows missing from where he had parked it the previous night. There is a Pittsburgh Steelers lanyard hanging from the rear-view mirror and a Steelers helmet logo on the gas tank lid.

**Theft from Vehicle/4000 blk W 2<sup>nd</sup>-** Complainant reported that his Sig Sauer Mosquito .22 pistol was stolen from his truck that was parked at the location. He also had 150 rounds of ammo that was stolen from the truck. There was no damaged to the truck as **it was apparently left unlocked**. There are no suspects.

**Voyeurism/1100 Blk N Columbia Center Blvd-** Officers and Crime Stoppers took calls on tips reference the identity of a voyeur using a cell phone to take pictures of women changing in the dressing room earlier in the day. Follow up continuing.

**Auto Theft/1300 blk N Columbia Center Blvd-** Complainant parked her car in the mall parking lot at about 08:00. She works in the mall and when she returned to her car at

16:00 her car was gone. The car has been reported and entered as stolen. The vehicle is gold 1996 Honda Accord. There is peeling paint on the trunk and a baby on board sticker in the rear window.

## CAT

**Warrant Arrest/6500 blk W Okanogan Ave-** Commander White requested CAT attempt to locate a 30 year old male and arrest him for Burglary with Sexual Motivation. Detectives conducted surveillance at his residence, but later in the evening located his car where he works. He was taken into custody without incident and booked into Benton County Jail.

**Trespass/2600 blk W Bruneau PI-** CAT detectives contacted a female leaving a restricted area of the building. She advised she stores her property inside the building the manager is aware of it. She advised nobody else was inside the building and wouldn't allow us to check without a warrant. The report was sent to the city attorney for review.


