**Friday, January 27, 2017**

### **D- Shift**

**Warrant Arrest/7900 blk W Clearwater Ave-** Officers responded to the location for a threats report, with a 3rd party advising that a male had made threats towards his mother. Investigation into the matter revealed the threats had been previously reported, and there were no new threats on this date. A records check of the male did however reveal valid warrants for his arrest and a no contact order between him and his mother. He was contacted at the location and arrested without incident.

**Domestic/1000 blk W 4th Ave-** Officers responded for a disturbance at the location after a friend stated she received a message on Face Book to call 911. On arrival, Officers contacted a female who appeared scared, and quietly told them that a male was in the back room. She stated they had been in an argument and she wanted him to leave. The male was contacted and left. A record check revealed that he is on probation and his conditions of release stated that he is not allowed to be at the location. Report forwarded to DOC for possible probation violation.

### **B-Shift**

**Stolen Recovery/Hood & Volland-** Officer Compton responded to Hood and Volland in reference to a vehicle left abandon in the middle of the road. The Honda Accord was unoccupied and had been stolen out of Kennewick. The owner responded and took possession of the vehicle.

### **CAT**

**False Reporting/6000 blk W Clearwater Ave-** CAT detectives contacted a suspicious male and female. The male provided a name and stated he didn't have any identification. The name he provided couldn't be found. He stuck to his story and had to

be let go. Awhile later detectives located his correct name and located 2 warrants for his arrest. A citation was sent to CA for False Reporting 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## Saturday, January 28, 2017

### D-Shift

**Narcotics/2800 blk W Clearwater Ave-** Male was arrested on a warrant and found to be in possession of meth after employees reported that he was acting strange, making them nervous, and possibly took part of a drug transaction. He was clearly under the influence of meth, was cleared at TRIOS and booked at the BCSO Jail.

**Narcotics/4600 blk W Clearwater Ave-** Male was arrested and found to be in possession of Meth after employees noted he was acting strange, eating food as he moved through the store and concealing merchandise. He was highly agitated and bantering during the investigation. He was booked at the BCSO Jail.

**Auto Theft/7600 blk W Clearwater Ave-** A 2004 gray and white Chevy Monte Carlo, was stolen from the location **after it was left running and unattended** when the driver went in to Starbuck's. No leads or suspects. Vehicle entered in ACCESS.

**Auto Theft/1200 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-** A white 2010 Chevrolet Traverse belonging to a auto dealership was stolen from the parking lot **when it was left running and unattended** while the driver, a sales person went into the store. No plate on the vehicle. No leads or suspects. Vehicle entered in ACCESS.

### B-Shift

**Malicious Mischief/100 blk E 4th Ave-** Complainant reported that she had gone to the location to drop off property belonging to her ex-boyfriend. The two got into an argument and she retreated into the residence. The male proceeded to vandalize her vehicle, tear the stereo out of the dash and punctured 3 of the 4 tires. He fled the scene prior to police arrival. Case forwarded to the Prosecutor for charging.

**Reckless Burning/300 blk S Jefferson St-** Complainant reported that his neighbor walked over to his residence and poured gas on the snow in his driveway. He then lit the gas on fire and fled. There was a small fire but it caused no damage. Officers made contact at the suspect's residence and spoke with his father. The residence and property were searched but the suspect was not located. Complainant and suspect have an ongoing feud over a female that they both date. Case forwarded to City Attorney for charging.

**Community Care Fund/ 3900 blk W 27th Ave-** Crime Analyst sent out information regarding a suspicious vehicle which has been seen parked in the parking lot over the

past few days. Sgt. Walters checked the area tonight and located the vehicle under a display carport in the parking lot. The windows were covered from the inside with cardboard. Contact was made with a female. She and her 14 year old daughter have been living in the vehicle and sleep there at night. She advised that with child support she does not qualify for state assistance. The community care fund was used to get the two a room for Saturday and Sunday. She was provided with resource information on obtaining temporary housing and other assistance.

## **CAT**

***Reckless Driving/Parkade-*** Detectives Bennett and Riley were conducting drug court checks in the downtown area and observed an Acura TSX traveling at a high rate of speed on Kennewick Ave. The vehicle was located and stopped. The male driver was cited for reckless driving due to the high volume of pedestrians in the area.

***Warrant Service & Located Runaway/00 blk Vista Way-*** Detectives Bennett and Riley contacted a 1 year old male. He lied about his name and was booked into juvenile for a warrant and runaway out of Pocatello, ID.

### **D- Shift**

***Auto Theft/100 blk W 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave-*** Complainant reported she attended an after-hours party at the location last night, parking her car out front. Today when she woke up, her car was missing. Investigation with uncooperative witnesses revealed possible suspects. The vehicle, a black 2009 Toyota has been entered in ACCESS as stolen.

***Burglary/800 blk S Alder-*** Complainant reported someone had broken into a shed on the property and stole a Sony PS4 and a TV during the night. No leads or suspect information.

### **B-Shift**

***Shoplift/4600 blk W Clearwater Ave-*** Loss prevention observed two juvenile females conceal make up items and then exited the store without paying. The two juveniles were detained and the property was recovered. Both females are currently living at My Friend's Place and were released to an employee of the facility.

## **Monday, January 30, 2017**

### **C Shift**

**Theft/2900 blk W 19th Ave-** Reporting kicked her boyfriend out of the house afterward found two cell phones missing. She suspects he took the phones. Upon contact he was cooperative and denied taking the phones.

**Theft/500 blk S Garfield St-** Complainant **left her purse in her unlocked truck** this morning and when she returned, an hour and a half later, she found her purse missing from her truck. No suspects.

**Malicious Mischief/100 blk S Washington-** Pink Graffiti was found on a city light post at the location. The words were not discernable.

**Weapons/300 blk N Underwood St-** A neighbor found an arrow in his yard this morning and suspected it belonged to nearby resident. Male admitted he was practicing his archery last night and skipped an arrow off the target. He was very apologetic and warned. City Attorney's office confirmed no crime.

## **A Shift**

**Field Contact/100 blk Vista Way-** Complainant has complained about another business and people associated with in the past. He called after two suspicious males had been loitering in the alley behind the business. One of the males entered the business and went into the girl's locker room. There was no one in the locker room at the time. Officers contacted the male as he walked away from the location. He was not cooperative at first. He was trespassed from the Dance Connection.

**Warrant Arrest/7000 blk W Canal Dr-** The store called due to a male and female in the store who was known to have previously shoplifted from them. They did not want them in the store. Officers contacted both of the subjects. Both were trespassed from the store and the male was booked on a Benton County felony warrant.

**Burglary Attempt/1400 blk W 4<sup>th</sup> Ave-** Complainant left for work early in the morning and returned in the afternoon to find her front door jamb damaged. The lock on the door along with the door jamb had been damaged. The deadbolt held and it did not appear that anyone gained entry. No suspects.

**DV Order Violation/400 blk N Hartford-** Officers responded to the location for an order violation that had just occurred. Contact was made with the female victim who advised that her husband was following her and texting her in violation of a court order. At the time of the call he was not located. Approximately 2 hours after the initial call he flagged down an officer and turned himself in. He was intoxicated and cleared at Trios before being booked.

**Graffiti/300 blk E 10<sup>th</sup>** Officers responded to the area for a report of several juvenile males spray painting a fence behind the location. Three of the suspects were spotted standing on the corner of 8<sup>th</sup> and Date. When they saw the officer all three ran in different directions. One of the suspects was followed by officers and detained after slipping in the snow. He admitted to the graffiti, but would not identify his friends. He was booked into juvenile on a warrant, malicious mischief and obstructing.
