
Do your part to help protect our waters.”

ILLICIT DISCHARGE DETECTION AND ELIMINATION PROGRAM



Stormwater runoff from streets, parking lots and driveways can contain common pollutants such as pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, oils, heavy metals, sediment, bacteria from animal waste and other debris. These pollutants can damage water quality and can contaminate our recreational waterways.




Pollutants dumped onto our streets or in our storm drains **DO NOT** go to our wastewater treatment plants to be cleaned. Instead these pollutants are discharged directly into the storm system that can be discharged into our rivers and creeks.

The purpose of reporting an illicit discharge is to help the four city's identify and eliminate the discharges in order to maintain and improve the quality of the water flowing into the Columbia River, the Yakima River, Zintel Canyon and Amon Creek.

What is an Illicit Discharge?

Illicit Discharge is any discharge to a city storm sewer that is not composed entirely of stormwater.
