



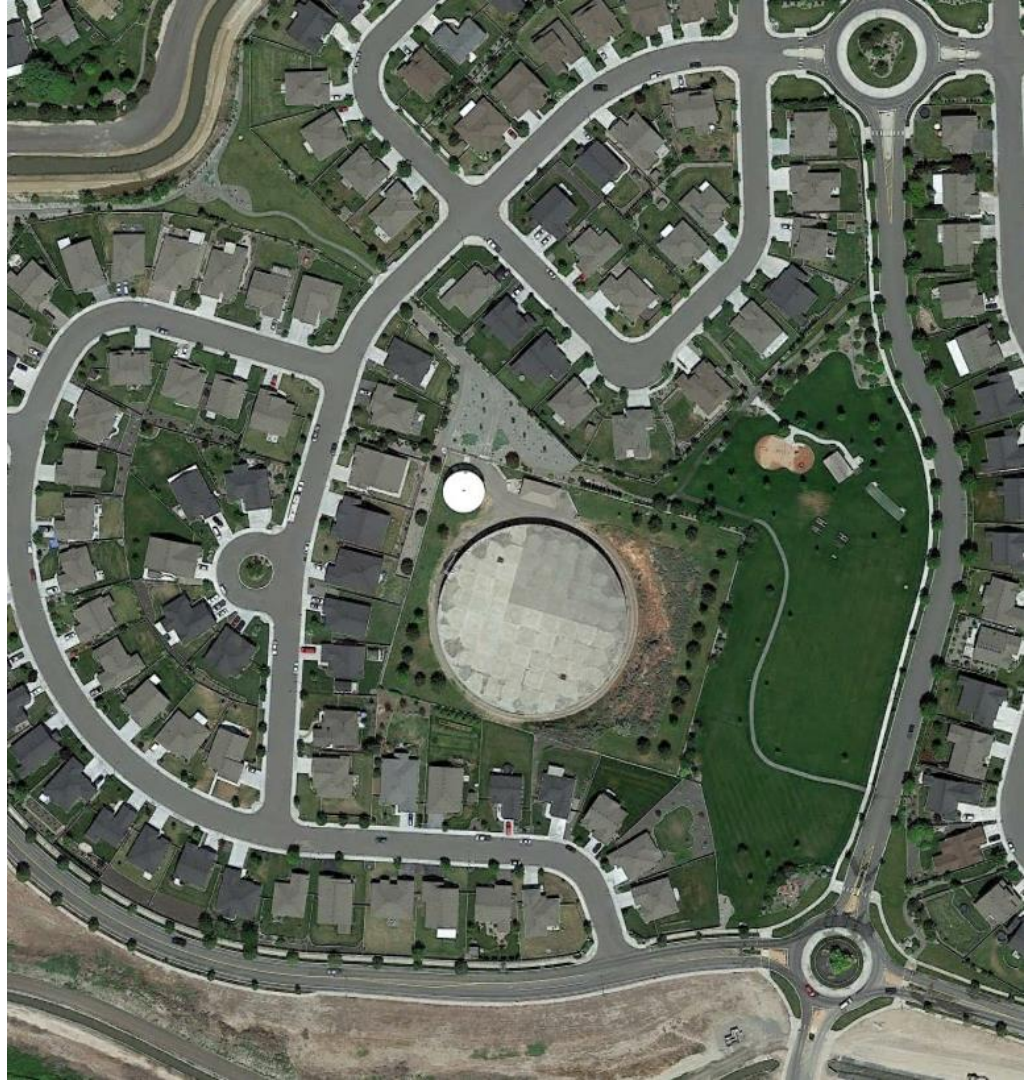

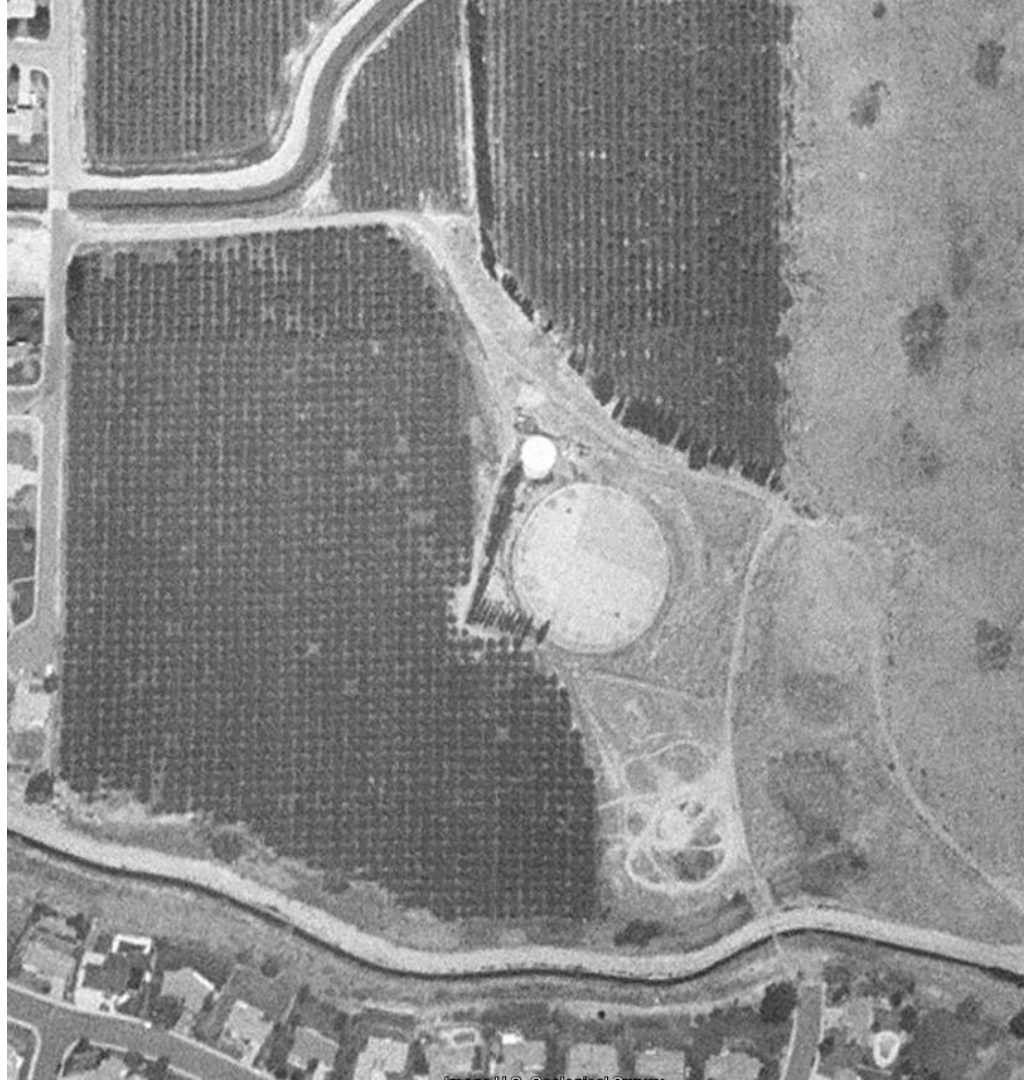

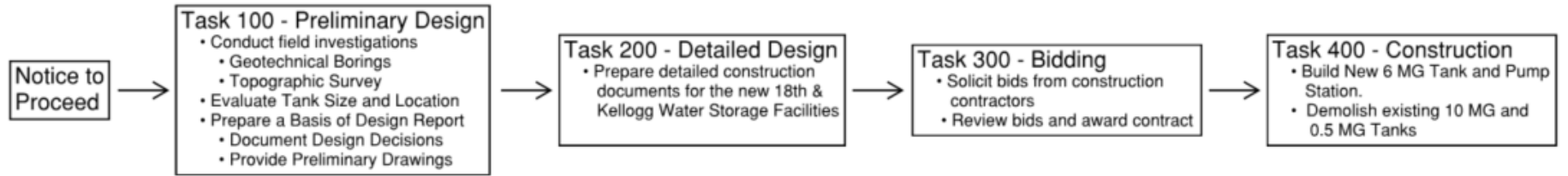

PROJECT BACKGROUND

- 0.5 MG Steel Tank was built in 1954
- 10 MG Concrete Reservoir was built in 1959
- Key facility in City's water system
 - Serves water demand and fire storage needs for Pressure Zone 2.
 - Supplies water to Pressure Zone 3 via pump station. Creekstone is within zone 3.
- In the past the City has performed several "fix up" projects to extend service life of the 10 MG Tank
- After 60 years of service the time has come to replace the Tank

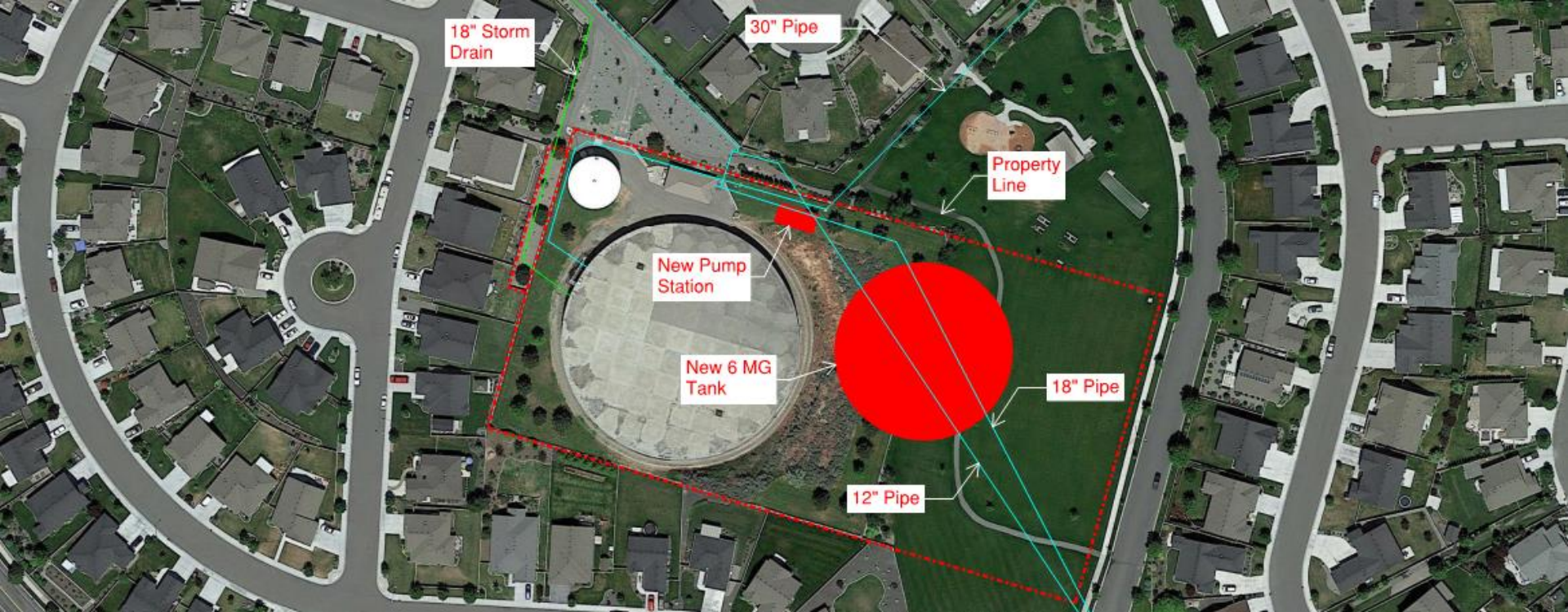




PROJECT SCOPE
