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Knox HomeBox

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What is a Knox HomeBox?

A Knox HomeBox is a secure, residential-grade, key safe that can only be accessed by your fire department 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide peace of mind and safety to your property, loved ones, and pets.

When is a Knox HomeBox Recommended?

The Kennewick Fire Department highly recommends the use of a Knox HomeBox for use at homes where the occupant may not be able to open the door to first responders in an emergency, without property damage.

Please call our office at (509) 585-4302 to schedule a time for our staff to come out and lock up the spare key once you have the box and spare key ready. If you have a medical alert company, you will need to notify them after the box is installed that you have a Knox box so the information will be relayed when a call goes into dispatch from their office.
